WHEREAS, many state and national professional education associations hold celebrations during the week of April 6-12, 2024 focused on honoring our young children and those that serve as their Early Care and Education teachers or providers and to enhance public support; and the future of our community depends on the quality of the early childhood experiences provided to young children today through well-planned instruction and activities children will develop the skills, confidence, and self-esteem to succeed; and by calling attention to the need for high-quality early childhood services for all children and families within our community, these groups hope to improve the quality and availability of such services; and the Census Bureau reports that approximately fifty-nine percent of working families rely on child care providers to help them care for their children while they work; twenty-one percent rely on relatives for child care; and nearly thirty-five percent arrange work schedules so that no child care is needed, substantiating the importance for high-quality early education._
