WHEREAS, School psychology has more than 60 years of well established, widely recognized, and highly effective practice and standards that are clearly articulated in the National Association of School Psychologists' Model for Comprehensive and Integrated School Psychological Services: and

WHEREAS, School psychologists are specially trained to foster and deliver, in the school and community, a continuum of mental health services and academic supports that lower barriers to teaching and learning; and

WHEREAS, School psychologists help children thrive by nurturing their individual strengths across both personal and academic endeavors; and

WHEREAS, School psychologists are trained to assess student- and school-based barriers to learning and individual strengths, use data-based decision-making, implement research-driven prevention and intervention strategies, and evaluate outcomes and improve accountability; and

WHEREAS Fresno County should recognize the vital role that school psychologists play in the personal and academic development of our county's children,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fresno County Board of Education and the Fresno County Superintendent of Schools do hereby proclaim November 6-10, 2023 as School Psychology Week in the County of Fresno and commend observance to all of our citizens and encourage all Fresno County School Districts to participate with appropriate activities and curriculum on this day and throughout the year.
