

PUBLIC HEARING

- TOPIC:** Conduct Public Hearing in the matter regarding Sufficiency or Insufficiency of Instructional Materials of the Fresno County Superintendent of Schools (County Superintendent)/Fresno County Board of Education (County Board) Court and Community Schools and County Superintendent Special Education Programs.
- ISSUE:** This Public Hearing will give the public an opportunity to address any concerns regarding sufficiency or insufficiency of instructional materials available to students attending the County Superintendent/County Board Court and Community Schools and County Superintendent Special Education Programs.
- BACKGROUND:** As a condition of compliance with Education Code Section 60119, the County Board is required to annually hold a public hearing and thereafter adopt a resolution stating whether each pupil enrolled in County Superintendent/County Board school(s) or County Superintendent Programs has, or will have within two months of the beginning of the school year, sufficient textbooks or instructional materials in each subject consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum frameworks adopted by the State Board of Education.
- The Public Hearing must be held and action must be taken on or before the eighth week of school at a time that will encourage the attendance of teachers and parents and guardians of pupils who attend County Superintendent/County Board school(s) or County Superintendent Program(s) and not during or immediately following school hours.
